

**Lake Linden-Hubbell Public Schools
Board of Education
Regular Meeting
November 13, 2023**

A Regular Meeting of the Lake Linden-Hubbell Schools Board of Education was held in the Auditorium on Monday, November 13, 2023. The meeting was called to order by President Patricia Burton at 5:30 p.m.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Jennifer Beaudette and supported by Rob Johnson to excuse David Anderson from the meeting. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Rob Johnson and supported by Lori Ambuehl to accept the agenda. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Jennifer Beaudette and supported by Courtney Holzberger to accept the November bills (totaling \$128,676.35), the Treasurer's Report and the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on October 9, 2023. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

There were no expressions from the public.

Mr. Brad Codere gave a Superintendent/6-12 Principal Report. Parent-Teacher Conferences were held on November 8. The High School Bowl team won their second match over Rudyard and now move on to the "Cerebral 16." The Veteran's Day assembly was held on November 10 with our band and local veterans participating. After analyzing data from the end of last year and beginning of this year, the Middle/High School MTSS team will be focusing on attendance and course pass rate. The TV-6 Can-A-Thon will run through November 23. Each grade that meets their goal will get to watch a movie. Thanksgiving Break is next week, November 22-24. The Christmas Band Concert is scheduled for Sunday, December 10.

Mr. Jack Johnson gave an Elementary Principal's Report. Parent-Teacher Conferences were held by appointment on November 8. The GSRP program has added two students and lost one which brings the enrollment to 14. The Elementary PTO is holding a "Glow Dance" on November 18. This event will include dancing, and arts/crafts. The School Spelling Bee is tentatively scheduled for January 10, 2024 with the District Bee at Dollar Bay on January 31. Due to the weather, the Halloween Parade was held inside on

October 31. Parents and families came to the high school gym to watch the class parades. The Elementary Christmas Program will be held on December 13. The RISE prize cart goes around every Monday to reward students for RISE behaviors. The primary focus has been on positives behaviors during unstructured settings such as the gym, playground and bus. The summary of discipline referrals for the first quarter was reviewed.

Mr. Jack Kumpula gave an Athletic Director's Report.

A motion was made by Lori Ambuehl and supported by Jennifer Beaudette to recognize student athletes and coaches for honors earned during the 2023 Football and Volleyball seasons. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Jennifer Beaudette and supported by Courtney Holzberger to approve the District audit report for the District accounts/funds as submitted by Anderson, Tackman & Company, PLC for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2023. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Jeff Dennis and supported by Jennifer Beaudette to approve the contract as presented between the Lake Linden-Hubbell School District and Great Lakes Recovery Centers for the Employee Assistance Program (EAP). Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Lori Ambuehl and supported by Jennifer Beaudette to accept the letter of resignation from Ayla Zambrano from her position as Elementary Parapro. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

The status of the school social worker position for next year was discussed.
